ANN MORGAN

Ann Morgan is an artist living in Denver by way of Michigan, New York City and Washington, D.C. She graduated with a Bachelor's of Fine Art from Michigan State University with a year as an Americorps*VISTA. Along the way she learned HTML and started making websites and digital art, which she started referencing in her paintings. After graduating and a short stint at NYU, she spent 20 years in tech: teaching computer classes, working at a software company, and then a tech-oriented position at an association. Burned out and wondering about painting again, she began working from a studio in Denver creating largescale oil paintings incorporating the influence natural world and digital life as it has evolved.

I've spent my personal and professional life virtually: Developing websites, playing video games, textonly friendships with people that might not exist. Post-pandemic, living digitally through screens is inescapable and the shared current human experience. I start from this new reality to create large-scale landscapes in oil paint - my current work draws from images I prompt from an AI model trained on my own photos, friends' social media and things they have shared. I use Photoshop and several AI platforms to manipulate and play until I have my own digital version of what lies outside. I use AI as a form of automatism, accessing the material from my own past and work, as well as the collective conscious of the internet as my unconscious mind. Working backwards from traditional landscape painting, I make my flat digital image mashups into large physical objects only experienced fully in real life. The heroic landscape painting, in history, is a depiction of an ideal world with ties to the reality of nature - my idealized reality is virtual.
